FLORENCE SEMESTER ABROAD

This unique program is offered to enable students to study abroad while making normal progress toward their degree objectives, and earning fully transferable, degree-applicable units in courses taught by community college faculty and guest lecturers. The program is offered in cooperation with several California community colleges and with the American Institute for Foreign Study (AIFS), which arranges transportation, living accommodations, and a wide range of student and instructional support services. Students need not be currently enrolled at one of the sponsoring colleges in order to participate. Financial aid is available. Units earned in Florence will appear on transcripts issued by the participating colleges. (Application deadline for Spring 2016 is in October 2015). ITALIAN 50B. BEGINNING ITALIAN CONVERSATION, PART 2

Solidify & improve your speaking/listening skills! *SPEAK* to your TIFU (The Italian in Front of You)!

Italian 50B is ideal for anyone who has already had a bit of Italian, and would like to "get to the next level," whether that is Italian 2, 3, or 4, or the new course, Italian through Film 70A, or just go to Italy!

The course will be centered around conversation patterns, self-expression, and use of the most frequently-used words/verbs, conversational structures, with correct pronunciation encouraged. There will be an initial review of basic grammar, followed by introduction of past tenses, pronouns, adjectives, etc., all at the service of conversational fluidity.

Topics will include: **How to survive in an Italian conversation.** / **What *do* Italians talk about?** / **Searching for your personal interests in Italy.** / **What's in a town & how do you find what you want?** /
